Pendleton and Gustafson suggest that the Medicare RAC program will definitely change the landscape of the health care environment prompting providers to pay careful attention to medical documentation and coding practices. The authors encourage all physicians to take measures to enhance current documentation practices keeping in mind that records could be selected for audit at some point in the future.

However, all is not gloom and doom. According to Gustafson, "Medicare providers and suppliers must be aware that RAC denials and overpayment demands can be successfully appealed through the established Medicare appeals process."

Pendleton continues, "Providers should definitely take advantage of the appeals process. We have seen many providers write-off claims that are winnable. For purposes of defending denied claims, having perfect documentation is certainly not the key to prevailing."

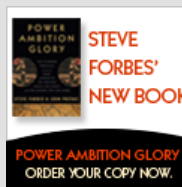
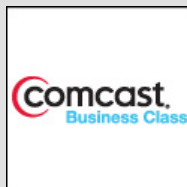
