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### WILL THE RACS ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY UNDERPAYMENTS?

Recovery Audit Contractors ("RACs") are tasked to identify both underpayments and overpayments. Although historica data establishes that RACs will likely focus their auditing activities on overpayments as opposed to underpayments, RACs will attempt to identify underpayments as well. In fact, during the course of the three-year demonstration program, the RACs identified and ordered repayment of \$37.8 million in underpayments to Medicare providers and suppliers.

On October 4 through October 6, 2009, The HLP partner Abby Pendleton spoke at the 2009 American Health Lawyers Association ("ALHLA") Fraud and Compliance Forum on the topic of "Recovery Audit Contractors and Medicare Audits: Lessons Learned and the Road Ahead." Ms. Pendleton co-presented with attorney Donald Romano and with Connie Leonard, Director of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services ("CMS") Division of Recovery Audit Operations.

During this presentation, Ms. Leonard confirmed that RACs are tasked to identify all types of improper payments, both underpayments and overpayments. Ms. Leonard indicated that although RACs will not entertain suggestions from specific providers regarding areas in which to look for underpayments, RACs will consider suggestions from provider organizations (e.g., hospital associations, other professional associations) regarding areas in which to look for underpayments. Therefore, providers that are aware of areas involving potential underpayments should be assertive in communicating with their professional associations, and encourage their professional associations to communicate with the RACs regarding these areas.
